Memorandum of Understanding

Mercer Island Education Association (MIEA) and the Mercer Island School District (MISD) desire to provide educational equity for all students. Recognizing McKinney-Vento identified students represent a class of students furthest from educational justice the MIEA and the MISD agree to the following:

Students who are identified McKinney-Vento students may receive in-person services in District facilities. The District will establish the following plan before providing in-person services to these students:

- The location in the building the student will access services.
- Identify who is assigned supervision and oversight of the student.
- Identify who will check the attestation of the student(s) before the student enters the building.

Employees who are impacted by the in-person services will be notified of the plan. Whoever provides the student supervision and oversight will receive training on health and safety expectations when working with a student, health attestations, food services (if meals are involved), transportation, student breach of safety, and special services if applicable.

If an employee has been assigned to supervise and oversees a student and has other duties that are impacted, they will meet with their supervisor to discuss a restructuring of job duties.
