This program provides financial assistance to students who have financial need and have exhibited integrity and perseverance in overcoming personal adversity. Scholarship criteria also include high school completion by spring 2020, commitment to pursue and complete a career or technical certificate/degree, Pell eligibility, student is under age 30 and United States citizenship. There is no GPA requirement for this scholarship. The association will award 1020 scholarships in 2020 with a maximum award amount of \$2,500 depending on the length of the program and needs of the student.
