


Classlink 3rd-5th Tools and Tips

ClassLink is a great way to access the many school tools available to your child to support learning at home.

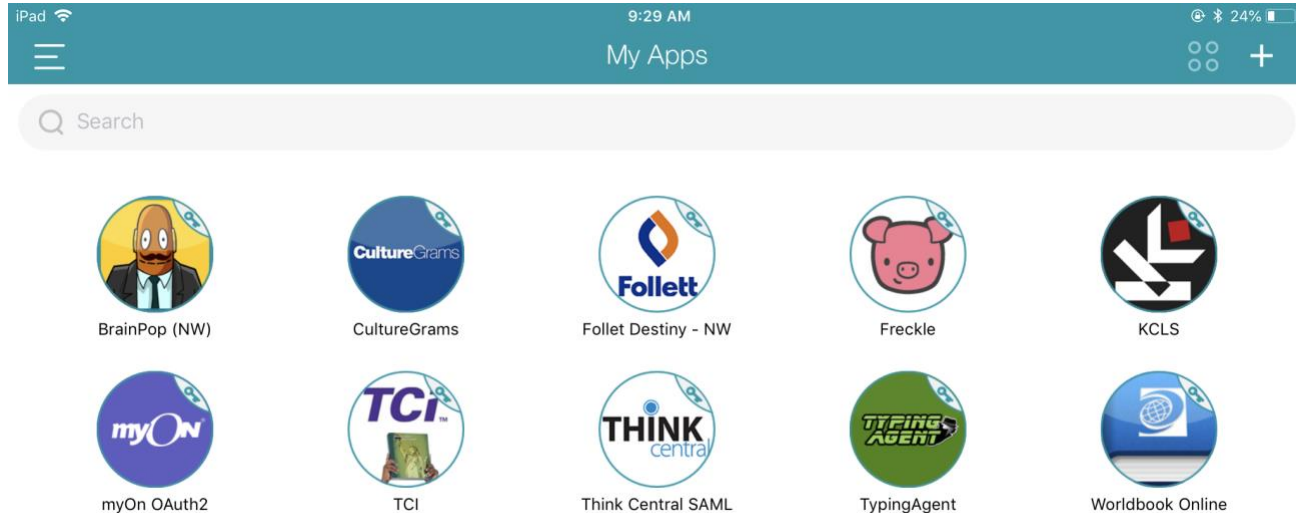
Remember that intermediate grade students access Classlink by either the app on tablets or this website on computers <https://launchpad.classlink.com>.

They need to click the "Sign in with Google" option and enter their school credentials:

Tip: Check for capitals and extra periods if your child is having trouble.

Below is a quick tour of the tools you can find there and recommended use.



BrainPop (and BrainPop Jr) a large connection of content rich animated videos with quizzes and activities. A great way to browse and grow interests, extend content area knowledge, or just watch the movie of the day.

CultureGrams – a powerful and engaging online database with images, articles, maps and interviews for countries around the world.

Follett Destiny -- access to school library book search and research tools.

Freckle – Adaptive math and reading for K-8th grade standards. An excellent way to fill conceptual gaps and extend learning in math and to practice at level reading with short articles as well as word study phonics skills. Program recommends 20-60 minutes or 4-6 completed lessons weekly. ****Please limit parental help so program can adjust to your child's skills and next steps.** Student should use the program's help video tutorials for assistance.)

KCLS – King County Library student account access. Log in information comes home on a bookmark after school librarian introduces it with classes.

MyOn – a collection of digital books with audio support. Each book is followed by a quiz, and periodic Lexile check ins to track growth in vocabulary understanding. Program recommends 20 minutes of online reading in myOn.

TCI – Student textbook and interactive notebook for our Science curriculum. A good way to catch up if your child is absent or explore the science your child is learning as a family. Please stick to current unit lessons.

ThinkCentral – Access the Math Expressions student text in the library section. Navigate to lesson to see text. Select the link icon to download printable homework and remembering pages.

Typing Agent – keyboarding foundation skill building and games. Program recommends 10-15 minutes 2 times a week.

Wordbook Online – an online encyclopedia with articles, copyright free images and bibliography tools. Kids or Student sections are best suited to elementary learners.
